The ministry of 'follow-up' grew out of evangelistic crusade ministries in the last century to describe the process of establishing a new believer in faith in Christ. The initial 'decision for Christ' needed to be followed up with personal Bible study, prayer and encouragement. It is the ministry of building strong foundations in the knowledge of God, leading to maturity and stability in the face of false doctrine. It is the ministry of encouraging the new convert to persevere in the spiritual battle, when confronted with doubt and opposition. (Gal 4:8-20; Eph 4:11-16; Col 2:6-8; 1 Thess 2:17-3:5; 2 Thess 2:13-17; Heb 10:19-25)
