The Ministry Intensive is a joint venture of the Ministry Training Strategy and Trinity Theological College



Participants will attend two workshops, one on each day. The workshops are offered at Introductory and Master Class levels. Numbers will be limited to ensure the workshops are engaging for participants. Three workshops are repeated on day 2 (*).

Introductory level:

Making your church evangelistic*

Mark Parsons is Associate Pastor at North Beach Baptist Church where he oversees evangelistic training and outreach. This workshop will outline how to create an evangelistic culture in our churches from the ground up.

Keeping God's word central in my ministry*

Matt Greenwood is church planter and Senior Pastor of Western Suburbs Community Bible Church, Mt Claremont. This workshop will provide a framework for and practical ways to keep the Scriptures as the foundation of a church and its ministries

Training in ministry one-to-one (for men)*

Peter Smit is the Pastor of Gateway Community Church. He was involved with planting this church and has given himself to growing ministry leaders. This workshop seeks to equip you to understand the basics of how to coach and equip men for future leadership and nurture them to maturity as Christians

Training in ministry one-to-one (for women)

Rosemary Thorburn serves as Senior Staff worker with the AFES at UWA, where she disciples women for maturity and ministry. This workshop aims to equip women to understand the basics of how to nurture others to maturity as Christians, and coach and equip them for future ministry.

Keeping God's word central in a team

Duane Olivier learnt Word ministry from Richard Coekin, planted a church in Durban (South Africa) and now is a teaching elder at Kingsley Presbyterian Church. He says, "Our aim should be to grow a team of people committed to Word ministry in the Church".

Training Trainers

Tim Thorburn has pastored churches in urban and rural WA, and is now an AFES Staff worker at UWA, where he trains students and ministry apprentices. The workshop is aimed at those who already equip the saints, but also want to equip them to equip others (2Tim 2:2).

Richard Coekin is the Senior Minister of the Co-Mission Initiative in London – a network of churches throughout South and West London. Richard studied law at Cambridge before training for gospel ministry. Under his leadership, the Co-Mission Initiative has seen vibrant growth - of churches and church plants in the UK. His aim has been to equip others to be faithful, passionate, godly servant leaders and look to God to give growth. He brings a precious combination of theological depth and clarity of vision to our task of labouring for the growth of Christ's kingdom in the local church.

Richard is a compelling speaker and will be terrific at engaging in conversation with us about the nuts and bolts of Christian ministry. This is a rare opportunity to sit under and beside a true brother in the cause of Christ.
